- Devoting at least 4 hours daily to the care of the relative for at least the last 3 months.

- Access to a computer, laptop, or tablet with internet access

- Online screening survey
- Surveys on a cell phone over 3 weeks (1 month apart)
- Online surveys before/after mobile surveys
- Wearing a provided smartwatch
- Up to \$255 compensation for your time
- No major risks or benefits
